ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WILDER COMMUNITY BUILDING ASSOCIATION, INC.

* * * * *

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming and organizing a non-profit, benevolent and charitable organization under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 11, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and hereby make, subscribe and execute the following Articles of Incorporation of said association, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

NAME

That the name of this corporation is: WILDER COMMUNITY BUILDING ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

PURPOSES AND POWERS

This corporation is a non-profit organization and is formed for benevolent and charitable purposes and especially as follows:

To build, erect, maintain, equip, manage and operate a community civic building or buildings to be used as a meeting place for civic clubs, service organizations and public meetings, and to that end adopt and establish by-laws and make all rules and regulations deemed necessary and expedient for the management of its affairs in accordance with law, and not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation; and to take, manage and hold and dispose of property, real and personal of said corporation.

ARTICLE III.

PLACE OF BUSINESS

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Wilder, County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

TERM OF EXISTENCE

The time for which said corporation shall be created shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V.

CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation does not have and shall not have any capital stock, and neither shall it issue to its members certificates representing capital stock, and this corporation shall not be operated for a pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE VI.

DIRECTORS

The number of directors of this corporation shall be five and the term of office, qualifications of directors and manner of election shall be provided for in the By-Laws. ARTICLE VII..

PROOF OF PUBLICATION AND
HOLDING OF AN ELECTION

Pursuant to a notice published in the Wilder Herald, a newspaper published in the City of Wilder, County of Canyon, State of Idaho, which notice was published on March 19th and March 26th, 1965, a copy of which notice and affidavit of publication thereof is attached to these Articles of Incorporation, a meeting of the members of the Wilder Community Building Association, Inc., was held on March 31st, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M., at which time and place a majority of the members of this association were present and voted at said election held at said meeting, and the persons whose names are set out in Article VI herein, were duly elected as the incorporating Directors for the first year of this corporation, and until election and qualification of their successors, and that Carl D. Mayes and Glenn Osborn were the Chairman and Secretary respectively of said meeting and officers conducting said election.

ARTICLE VIII.

AMENDMENTS

These articles may be amended in any respect at any regular meeting of this corporation by a vote of the majority of the quorum attending such meeting; provided that public notice of intention to amend the Articles of Incorporation shall have been given by publication at least once a week for four weeks in a newspaper published in the county wherein such meeting is to be held, such notice to designate the regular meeting at which it is intended to vote on the proposition of amending said Articles of Incorporation, and shall state the manner in which it is intended to amend the Articles of Incorporation.
