

I, the undersigned individual, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1 - Name

The name of this corporation is Palouse-Clearwater Hanford Watch Incorporated, hereafter called PCHW.

Article 2 - Duration

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

Article 3 - Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively for the promotion of social welfare for educational purposes as a civic group within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code. Such purposes shall include:

A. To identify, study and educate citizens of the Pacific Northwest on the economic, social, health and environmental impacts, costs, and consequences of nuclear weapons production, disposal of byproducts and transportation of these nuclear materials through the region;

B. To provide forums for the free exchange of views on these matters of concern to the public

C. To carry on research and to make such research available for the benefit of the general public;

D. To inform and educate the public on issues of importance to the future of the Northwest and thus create a well-informed, active, and concerned citizenry ;

E. To inform and influence all levels of government on issues of importance to the Northwest.

Article 4 - Nonprofit Nature

A. This corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the assets receipts, or net earnings of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to ,any individual. This corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

C. A trustee or the entire board of trustees may be removed from office, with or without cause, by a majority vote of the membership of PCHW at a meeting called expressly for that purpose and having a quorum of one-third the registered members.

D. corporation officers shall be elected by the P.C.H.W. board to include a president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer. Any two or more offices may be held by the same person, except for the offices of president and secretary.

E. The general membership as described in corporate charter and bylaws must approve board members

Article 7 - Membership

There shall be two classes of membership - individual and group, with rights and privileges provided in the PCHW Charter and Bylaws.

Article 8 - Registered Agent and office

The initial registered agent and office of the corporation shall be: Chuck Broschious, 46C White Pines Flat Rd. PO Box 220, Troy, Idaho 83871.

Article 9 - Amendments

Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation shall be made in compliance with Sec. 30-326 of the Idaho Code.

Article 10 - Incorporator


