

AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the

THE KIRKPATRICK MEMORIAL COMMUNITY CHURCH, (Presbyterian)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned citizens and residents of the State of Idaho, and freeholders within the County of Canyon in the said State, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the Laws of the State of Idaho, a private corporation for religious and benevolent purposes, and we do hereby certify:

First. That the name of the said corporation shall be, "THE KIRKPATRICK MEMORIAL COMMUNITY CHURCH, (Presbyterian)"

Second. That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is to advance the principles of Christianity by establishing and maintaining religious worship and benevolent practices in accord with the doctrines and tenets of the Presbyterian Church of the United States of America, and of acquiring such real and personal property as may be deemed necessary to enable it to accomplish its religious and benevolent purposes.

Third. That the place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is Parma, Canyon County, Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of trustees of the said corporation shall be seven, two of whom shall be elected and

serve until the annual meeting of the corporation to be held in April, 1920, two until the annual meeting of the corporation to be held in April, 1921, and two until the annual meeting of the corporation to be held in April, 1922, and thereafter two shall be elected at each annual meeting of the members of the corporation. In the event of the death, resignation, or removal of any trustee, the Board of Trustees shall elect his successor to serve for the term specified in the By-Laws, or until his successor has been elected and qualified. The seventh trustee shall be chosen for life, but may be replaced by a majority vote of a quorum of the membership of the corporation.

The names and respective terms of the trustees to serve until their successors are elected and have qualified are:-

Seventh Trustee.

Mrs. Mary E. Kirkpatrick, a resident of Parma, Idaho, is hereby designated as a Trustee for her life, subject to the provisions in this paragraph hereinbefore set forth. At the first annual meeting of the corporation after the death of Mrs. Mary E. Kirkpatrick her successor shall be elected in like manner for life, subject to the provisions in this paragraph hereinbefore set forth. A trustee for life shall signify that a person has received this honor at the hands of the membership of the corporation because of distinguished

devotion to and service rendered this church.

Sixth. That there shall be no capital stock.

Seventh. That on the 7th day of January, 1920, at the Odd Fellows Hall in Parma, Canyon County, State of Idaho, the election of the above named trustees was confirmed by a majority of the membership of the said corporation. That a majority of the membership of the said corporation were then and there present.
