AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the said corporation has subsequently and on the **2nd** day of **June**, 19 **34**, paid the annual license tax and penalty assessed against it and the said **DESERT SHEEP COMPANY** is therefore reinstated on the records of this office, and all the corporate rights which it enjoyed under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Idaho prior to the date of said forfeiture, are hereby restored.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

DESERET SHEEP COMPANY.

Know all men by these presents:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are actual bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho and we hereby certify as follows:

-1-

That the name of the said corporation is "Deseret Shepp Company"

-11-

That the purposes and objects for which and for any of which this corporation is formed are:

a; To own, acquire, graze, run and in any manner to deal in and dispose of sheep and bucks of every kind, grade and description and their wool and increase.

b; To take, acquire, buy, hold, own, maintain, work develop, sell, convey, lease, mortgage, exchange, improve and otherwise deal in and dispose of real estate and real property or any interest and rights therein, without limit as to amount.

c; To take, acquire, buy, hold, own, sell, hire, lease, mortgage, pledge and otherwise deal in and dispose of all kinds of property, chattels and chattels real, without limit as to amount.

d; To lend money on bonds secured by mortgages on real

estate or upon personal property, or to lend money and make advances from time to time on bonds secured by mortgages for future advances on real estate or upon personal property, and to acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, hire or otherwise lands or any interest therein;

e; To borrow or raise money for any purpose of its incorporation, to issue its bonds, notes, or other obligations, for moneys so borrowed, or in payment of or in exchange for any real or personal property, or rights or franchises acquired, or other value received by the corporation, and to secure such obligation by pledge, or mortgage under deed of trust, or otherwise, of or upon the whole or any part of the property at any time held by the corporation, and to sell or pledge such bonds, or discount such notes or other obligations for its proper corporate purposes.

f; To have one or more offices to carry on all or any part of its operations or business, and unlimited and without restriction to conduct its business in any State or Territory of the United States, and to hold meetings of its Board of Directors for the transaction of any business of the corporation at any place outside of the State of Idaho or at any place in the State of Idaho other than its principal place of business;

g; To do all and ~~everything~~ necessary, suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated or incidental to the powers herein named, or which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation, and this to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do.

That the place where the principal business of the corporation is to be transacted shall be Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its corporation.

That the number of directors shall be three.

-VI-

That the capital stock of the corporation shall be ten thousand dollars divided into one thousand shares of the par value of ten dollars per share.
