ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Elk City Booster Club

Know all men by these presents:

That we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Idaho do hereby associate ourselves together to form a non-profit corporation, and in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 10 of Article 30, Idaho Code, and the laws of the State of Idaho relating to the organization of corporations where pecuniary profit is not the object, and we do hereby certify and declare as follows:

I.

NAME

The name of this corporation is Elk City Booster Club, Inc.

II.

PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business and post office address of this corporation shall be in Elk City, Idaho.

III.

DURATION

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

PURPOSES

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit nor shall it have any power to issue any capital stock, and no part of its earnings shall inure to any member, director or individual. The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows: To promote the welfare of Elk City, Idaho, and the region as a whole; to cooperate with all levels of government, local, state and federal, and with all interested private individuals and legal entities in the furthering of all such purposes; to accept and use all federal or state aid funds available, and any private funds which may be made available

to the corporation for its uses and purposes; to make all necessary studies and surveys, to borrow money, to buy, sell, hold, acquire, own, mortgage, hypothecate, transfer, lease, exchange, trade or otherwise to acquire or dispose of real and personal property; to exercise those powers commonly exercised by natural persons and to do all acts or things useful or incidental to the purposes for which this corporation is constituted.

VI.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of directors of the corporation shall be three (3).

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) directors whose names and addresses are as follows:

Larry McPherson, Elk City

Eugene Norby, Elk City

VII.

RIGHTS AND INTERESTS

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal. No member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member. This corporation shall not issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof. Such memberships shall be issued under such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the by-laws of the corporation.

VIII.

LIABILITIES

The members of the corporation shall not be individually or personally liable for the debts or liabilities of said corporation and the private property of the members of this corporation shall not be subject to any extent to any of the corporate debts whatever.

IX.

CHANGES

The corporation may amend, alter, add to, change or repeal any provision contained in these articles of incorporation in the manner provided by law.
