KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned residents of the State of Idaho, have voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, section 17 of the Civil Code of the State of Idaho.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

I

That the name of this corporation shall be-

II

The purposes of this corporation shall be:

- a) To establish a corporation organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes with no part of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any member of the corporation, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.
- b) To establish and operate for educational purposes, in such manner that the facility involved shall be funded by grants, donations and be as self sustaining as possible.
- c) To benefit the Treasure Valley population, Ada and Canyon County inclusive, with a focus on the under privileged therein, giving a *supplemental* education emulating established computer labs. Services will give a lasting effect of understanding to youth up through the elderly of all nations, races, creeds, religions, and colors through educational games using regular computer, and network applications. The beneficiaries of this service could learn as little as

- d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 ( c ) (3) of the Internal Revenue code, or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 ( c ) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
