ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
EMMANUEL CHAPEL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, all citizens and residents of the United States of America and of the State of Idaho, of legal age, acting as incorporators of a non-profit religious corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho, do adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be:

EMMANUEL CHAPEL, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The object, business, and purpose of this corporation is non-political, and shall be devoted to promoting scriptural, practical and personal holiness and holy living and shall be uncompromising in its teaching and world wide in its field; to uphold and maintain the Constitution of the United States of America and all sub-divisions thereunder, and to assist in the maintaining of law and order; to safeguard and transmit to posterity the purity and righteousness of individual freedom, and the teaching of our order, as well as to teach the same to our individual members and to the community at large; to assist in charitable work of any nature deemed beneficial and to the best interests of the order and to society as a whole, and to raise funds for carrying the same into effect in any manner allowed by the Constitution and by laws of the order, and permitted under the Laws of the State of Idaho and the Constitution of the United States of America.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post office address of this corporation shall be: Route 1, Box 351, Hayden Lake, Idaho.

This Corporation is not organized for profit and has no authority to issue capital stock.
