ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

(Non-profit)

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To the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho
Pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho code, the undersigned non-profit corporation
amends its articles of incorporation as follows:

1. Article 1: The name of this corporation shall be "Idaho Parents Unlimited, Inc."
2. Article III: The location of the registered office of this corporation shall be Nampa, Canyon County, Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho, and the address of the registered office of this corporation shall be 1878 W. Overland Rd., Boise, ID 83705, and the mailing address is P.O. Box 50126, Boise, ID 83705
3. Article IV: The nature of the business and the object and purpose of this corporation shall be: To obtain better services for all people with disabilities, regardless of race, religion, or ability to pay. To advise and aid parents in the solution of their problems and to coordinate their efforts and activities, through parent training. To develop a better understanding of the problems of people with disabilities by the public. To cooperate with all public, private, and religious agencies, and with professional groups in the furtherance of these ends. To do each and everything necessary, suitable, useful and advisable for the accomplishment of any one or more of the objectives of said corporation, or which shall at any time appear to be conducive to or expedient for the benefit of said corporation in connection therewith. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service code.
4. Article V: The number of directors constituting the Board of Directors is not less than 12 or more than 15. The method and conditions on which board members shall be accepted and discharged or expelled shall be by a vote of the full board members that currently exists. The time and place for the vote on electing board members will always occur during the non-profit corporation meetings. The election of the board members shall be by simple majority. These corporate meetings shall be open to all parents, relatives, and guardians, including foster

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parents of children with disabilities and any other person(s) or organizations to the purpose of the corporation who reside in the State of Idaho. The rights and interests of all members of the board of directors have voting privileges and shall be allowed to hold an office in this organization. The board members will be appointed by staggered 3 year terms as defined in the corporate by-laws. The mechanisms will provide for the development of a corporate association, the board membership of which will elect for regularly occurring board vacancies. These vacancies will be filled by the board chair with the approval of the board as a whole.

5. Article VI: In furtherance, and not in limitation, the powers conferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized: In general, shall be responsible for overseeing the function of the organization by: Developing programs to accomplish the goals of the committees. Participating in the selection of new committees. Supervising of committee members and the Executive Director of said corporation.
6. Article IX: These articles may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the board members of said corporation present and voting at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose.

The date of adoption of the amendment(s) was October 26, 2007.

The amendment consists of matters other than those described in section 30-3-90, Idaho Code, and was, therefore adopted by the members. a) The number of members entitled to vote was 20. The number of members that voted for each amendment was 20. c) The number of members that voted against each amendment was 2.
