Pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, the undersigned
non-profit corporation amends its articles of incorporation as
follows:

STATE OF IDAHO

1. The name of the corporation is:

North Idaho BMX, Inc.

2. The text of each amendment is as follows:

Change article 7 to read as follows: Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principle office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes. Add the following articles: Article 8: The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Article 9: Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
