ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

RONDYS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, Wilburn E. Hall and Dorothy Joyce Hall, each of whom is a citizen of the United States of America, in pursuance of the purpose to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate original, and state as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be RONDYS, INC.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business of the corporation and the object and purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted and carried on by it, are as follows:

(1) To engage in the ocean products business, both retail and wholesale sales; to own, lease and operate fishing boats; to deal with and sell ocean products of every nature and kind.

(2) To act as agent, broker, distributor or representative for any other person, corporation or otherwise, engaged in business of any nature.

(3) To manufacture, buy, sell, deal in, and to export and import, conduct and carry on the business of manufacturing, buying, selling, importing and exporting goods, wares and merchandise of every class and description.

(4) To purchase or otherwise acquire, so far as permitted by law, the whole or any of the undertaking and business of any person, firm or corporation engaged in any business for which this corporation is organized, and the property and liabilities, including the good will, assets and stock in trade thereof, and to pay for the same either in cash or in shares, or partly in cash and partly in shares.

(5) To the same extent as natural persons might or could do, to purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, exchange, hire, convey, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of and deal in, lands and leaseholds, and any interest, estate and rights in real property and any personal or mixed property, and any franchises, rights, business or privileges necessary, convenient and appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.

(6) To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise, and to hold for investment or otherwise, and to use, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise deal with or dispose of stocks, bonds, or any obligations or securities of any corporation or corporations; and to merge or consolidate with any corporation in such manner as may be provided by law.

(7) To borrow money, and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidence of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, except as may be prohibited by statute, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.

(8) To conduct and carry on its business, or any part thereof, and to have one or more offices and to exercise all or any of its corporate powers and rights in the State of Washington, and in the various states, territories and dependencies of the United States, in the District of Columbia, and in all or any foreign countries or country.

(9) To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinabove set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals and to do every act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business or powers, or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.
